### **LEGISLATIVE**

In an article published through the <u>Lubbock Avalanche</u> Journal's Austin bureau and authorized by Enrique Rangel, a federal court in San Antonio has heard arguments from both sides of the Texas Legislature and regarding congressional redistricting implementation of split elections. The three-judge federal panel comprised of both Republican and Democratic leaders discussed the feasibility of holding two primaries; one would be held in March exclusively for presidential races, and another one in May to decide congressional, state, and local contests. If the hearings legislative redistricting examining maps are completed, Democrats will favor a single April 3 primary date for all elections. Republicans are pushing for a March primary in order to maintain power in the GOP for president. However the only definitive action which came out of the day-long court hearing in San Antonio was a December 9 filing date extension for Democratic and Republican primaries.

Critics of split primaries cite several disadvantages. Split primaries could place a financial burden on counties. "I don't know where we would get the

money," lamented David Saucedo, country judge of Maverick Country in South Texas. "I guess we could downsize in other departments." He added that a primary costs Maverick County \$85,000. Jacque Callenen, Bexar County election administrator weighed in on the controversy. "I think," She opined, "that there is going to be a lot of confusion if you have several elections." Callenen feels this confusion could result in lower voter turn out. Also, a May primary could affect Bexar County and other local governments statewide that hold municipal and school board elections in May.

Recently, the three- judge federal panel crafted temporary maps for the 2012 legislative and congressional primary elections. Minority groups have sued the federal court claiming the maps drawn by the Legislative didn't reflect the growth of his panic and black populations in Texas. Texas Attorney General Greg Abbott has asked the U.S. Supreme Court to block the maps drawn by the panel accusing the federal judges of overstepping their authority. The high court agreed to hear oral arguments on the issue January 1.
