Greater Houston Council November 2018 Meeting

Toni Anne Dashiell, Texas' National Republican Committeewoman spoke at the November meeting of the Greater Houston Council of Federated Republican Women. The topic concerned the Electoral College vs. Popular Vote issue.

Did you know that the Presidential Election can be changed without a Constitutional Amendment!

#### The National Republican Party Platform states:

"We oppose the **National Popular Vote Interstate Compact** and any other scheme to abolish or distort the procedures of the Electoral College. An unconstitutional effort to impose National Popular Vote would be a grave threat to our federal system and a guarantee of corruption, as every ballot box in every state would offer a chance to steal the presidency. We urge state legislatures that have voted for this proposal to rescind their approval."

What the heck is that?

The National Popular Vote Interstate Compact is an agreement among a group of U.S. states and the District of Columbia to award all their respective electoral votes to whichever presidential candidate wins the overall popular vote in the 50 states and the District of Columbia. Wikipedia

#### Article Two, Section Two of the U. S. Constitution states:

"Each State shall appoint, in such Manner as the Legislature thereof may direct, a Number of Electors, equal to the whole Number of Senators and Representatives to which the State may be entitled in the Congress: but no Senator or Representative, or Person holding an Office of Trust or Profit under the United States, shall be appointed an Elector."

The National Popular Vote Interstate Compact (NPVIC), when adopted by the State Legislature **directs the Electors to cast Presidential and Vice-Presidential Votes per the national popular vote**. In effect, this turns the Presidential Elections into a National Popularity contest. The candidates will then focus on the most populous states (think bright blue California and New York) rather than the entire country.

What is the current status of NPVIC?

270 Electoral Votes are needed to make the change. Twelve states controlling 172 Electoral Votes have adopted NPVIC. Not surprisingly, these states are clustered on the East and West Coasts and Illinois. This means that only 98 Electoral Vote States are needed to turn the Presidential Election into a Popularity Contest.

What can CFRW do?

Toni Anne Dashiell presented some of our options during her eye-opening talk. The following action items were suggested:

- 1. Educate your friends and family. If any live in the twelve states previously adopted NPVIC, request rescission of the Compact.
- 2. Pass resolutions and present them to elected officials.
- 3. Work to have language mirroring the National Republican Party Platform inserted into the Texas State Republican Platform.
