vote for our Republican candidates. We like to brag that everything is bigger in Texas, but not voter turnout unfortunately. With data from the U.S. Census Bureau, Texas residents are ranked 47th in voter turnout; there are only fifty states. Texas is at the bottom of the barrel. Texas residents are ranked 44th in voter registration and only 32% of Texans aged eighteen to twenty-four, voted in the 2016 Presidential Election, the national average was 43%. Democrat primary turnout more than doubled since 2014. but not to fret. as Republicans cast over 1.5 million votes in the primary compared to 1 million votes cast by Democrats this primary season. We cannot become complacent; we need to increase our momentum and double our voter turnout.

We are the motivators for our state, we are workers, and the members of the Texas Federation of Republican Women are the reason Texas stays RED!"

**Gail Schubot, Legislative Chair,** gave a written report of the Governor's proposal he has titled "The Damon Allen Act." Governor Abbott plans to ask the Texas House of Representatives to consider adopting the legislation in January, 2019. **Suzanne Davis, Hospitality,** provided two door prizes.

# **CFRW Executive Board of Directors Election**

Below are the positions available for the 2019-2010 CFRW Executive Board. If you are interested in serving on this Board, please contact Jan Ott, Nominations Committee Chair. Other members elected to the Committee are: Darcy Mingoia, Gail Schubot, Rita Parrish and Amy Ramon.

This committee will present the 2019-2020 Slate of Officers at the October 9 meeting. The proposed slate will then be voted on at the November 13 meeting.

Below the list of Officers is a list of Committees that will need chairmen. The new President will appoint these positions with approval of the incoming Executive Board Officers. If you are interested, please let the Nominations Committee know so that they can give your name and interest to the incoming Board at the November meeting when they are elected.

#### Article V – Officers and Executive Board: Section 1. Elected Officers:

The officers of the organization shall be President, 1st Vice President, 2nd Vice President, 3rd Vice President, Secretary and PAC Treasurer.

#### Section 2. Duties of Officers:

- A. The President shall preside at all meetings of the organization and the Executive Board. She shall appoint chairmen of all standing and special committees with the approval of the Executive Board, shall appoint a Parliamentarian, shall serve ex officio as a member of all committees except the Nominating Committee, and shall have general supervision of the work of the organization.
- B. The 1st Vice President shall perform the duties of the President whenever the President is absent or otherwise unable to serve. She shall serve as Program Chairman and perform such other duties as the President or Executive Board or Board of Directors may designate.
- C. The 2nd Vice President shall assume the duties of President in the absence of the President and 1st Vice President. She shall serve as Ways & Means Chairman.
- D. The 3rd Vice President shall serve as CFRW Newsletter Editor and shall be responsible for publication of the newsletter.
- E. The Secretary shall keep a factual and unbiased record of the proceedings of all meetings of the organization and the Executive Board, shall prepare the correspondence of the organization, shall have custody of all records pertinent thereto, and shall perform such additional duties as may be required of the office.
- F. The PAC Treasurer shall receive and is custodian of all funds of the organization and shall pay all bills upon authorization by the President. The PAC Treasurer shall keep an account of all monies received and disbursed and shall give a report at each regular meeting of the organization to the membership. She shall make timely membership submissions and payments to TFRW. She shall be registered with TEC as Campaign Treasurer and ensure that adequate records are kept to satisfy the requirements of TEC and Texas election laws, and shall file all reports required by them in a timely fashion. She shall submit her financial records to the chairman of the Financial Review Committee for an end of the fiscal year no later than January 20. At the end of her term, the outgoing PAC Treasurer shall file the following January semi-annual GPAC report and termination report before transferring duties to the incoming PAC Treasurer.

#### Section 3. Executive Board:

The voting members of the Executive Board shall consist of the elected officers, the immediate Past President and the chairmen of the standing committees as described in Article VIII, Section 2. The Parliamentarian shall serve ex officio without vote.

# **CFRW Executive Board of Directors Election Cont'd.**

#### Section 4. Duties of the Executive Board:

The Executive Board shall have the authority to transact any necessary business between meetings, to make recommendations as to the policies of the organization and to advise the President.

#### Section 5. Term of Office:

The term of office for officers and committee chairmen shall be from January 1 through December 31 following their election or appointment for a term of two (2) years. No officer or chairman may serve in the same position for more than two (2) consecutive terms.


